RE: Recommended changes to the Secretary of State 2017 Campaign Finance Disclosure Report

Dear Mr. Hustead:

At the request of the Kristi for Governor campaign ("the Committee"), we have examined the campaign contributions (including more than 7,000 donation transactions), the Committee database, accounting records, and the correlating expenses for the periods reported on the Secretary of State Campaign Finance Disclosure Reports filed in 2017 and 2018.

Although we have not completed our review of 2018, we have finalized our recommendations regarding 2017. The changes we recommend are based on our independent examination of the committee records and with this letter we bring those matters to your attention in compliance with SDCL 12-27-27.

In making these recommendations, it is important to understand that any financial report is a snapshot of a moment in time, and some of the corrections or additions recommended herein refine that financial snapshot.

In particular, we note that many transactions for donated goods and services (often called "in-kind donations") were originally reported as cash contributions on the Secretary of State report. This means that while the donor names, addresses and amounts were publicly disclosed on reports filed with the Secretary of State, the entry as a cash transaction incorrectly added to the ending report cash balance of the Committee.

We expect to complete our review of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Reports filed in 2018 prior to the end of this month, and will forward our recommendations to you when that is finalized.
