Dear Secretary of State:

As you are aware and as referenced in statements made in prior filings with your office, nearly a year ago I asked for a third party professional to review all income and expenditures of the Committee. I have now received that report from Nelson & Nelson CPAs LLP, with technical amendments prepared by Nelson & Nelson and based on their review of all of the records and reports filed with your office.

In accordance with the above, I am submitting the following enclosures to your office for filing with the Committee records:

1. Third Amended 2018 Pre-Primary Campaign Finance Disclosure Report;
2. Third Amended 2018 Pre-General Campaign Finance Disclosure Report;
3. Amended 2018 Year-End Campaign Finance Disclosure Report; and
4. 2019 Year-End Campaign Finance Disclosure Report.

Please note that in the course of the independent review:

- A. Four corporate contributions were identified (as detailed on the Third Amended 2018 Pre-Primary and Third Amended 2018 Pre-General Campaign Finance Disclosure Reports). Although legally permissible, these corporate contributions are inconsistent with the 2018 campaign pledge to not accept corporate contributions and will be reflected as a refund on the next report filed with your office.
- B. Three direct contributions from individuals were identified (as detailed on the Third Amended 2018 Pre-General Campaign Finance Disclosure Report) where credit card donations were deposited but not matched to a specific donor. The unmatched individual contributions are being donated to charity as will show on the next report filed with your office.

Dear Mr. Hustead:

At the request of the Kristi for Governor campaign ("the Committee"), we have examined the campaign contributions (including more than 7,000 donation transactions), the Committee database, accounting records, and the correlating expenses for the periods reported on the Secretary of State Campaign Finance Disclosure Reports filed in 2017 and 2018.

The changes we recommend are based on our independent examination of the committee records and with this letter we bring those matters to your attention in compliance with SDCL 12-27-27.

In making these recommendations, it is important to understand that any financial report is a snapshot of a moment in time, and some of the corrections or additions recommended herein refine that financial snapshot.

In particular, we note that many transactions for donated goods and services (often called "in-kind donations") were originally reported as cash contributions on the Secretary of State report. This means that while the donor names, addresses and amounts were publicly disclosed on reports filed with the Secretary of State, the entry as a cash transaction incorrectly added to the ending report cash balance of the Committee.

We expect to complete our examination of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Reports filed in 2018 prior to the end of this month, and will forward our recommendations to you when that is finalized.
